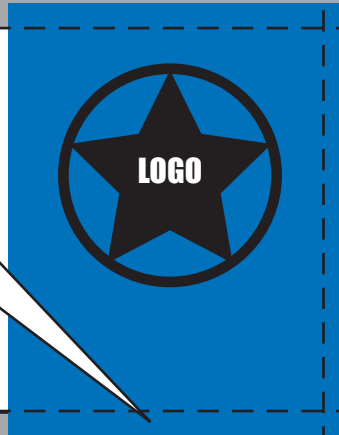


This is the minimum bleed area, any graphics or areas of color that you want to have extend to the edge of the card must go at least one eighth of an inch (0.125") beyond the edge of the card so that your design appears as you intended after we cut it to size (see below for example).



### Minimum Bleed Area

**(2.25" x 3.75" or 1/8 of an inch beyond the edge of each card)**

Whether or not your card has bleeds you should keep important text or graphics at least 0.25" from the edge due to limitations in cutting. See green area at right.



These dark areas are called "gutters." While the gutters are within the printable area, no information that falls in the gutter will show up on your cards. Sometimes printers marks like registration targets or crop marks will be added here.
